Bursary Fund Information Sheet

Introduction

The LCT Bursary Fund has been set up to provide financial assistance to independent students in meeting the fees of their programme of study at LCT. The Bursary Fund is a separate fund within the accounts of LCT and is administered by a committee of the Board of Trustees.

Grants

The LCT Bursary Fund will consider making grants to students who are accepted by LCT for any programme of study. Grants are available for one year and must be applied towards the annual registration fee or the module fees for the course for which the student is accepted. The award of grants and the amount of grants is wholly discretionary and, due to the limited size of the fund, LCT reserves the right not to award any grant in any year. As a guideline, it is expected that individual grants will normally be of the order of £200 per year, but the amount of any grant is wholly discretionary.

Eligibility

Applicants for grants must be independent students, that is to say not students who are sponsored by their relevant diocese and whose fees are paid on their behalf by the diocese. Although grants are for one year only, students may apply for an additional grant for a second or subsequent year of study, subject to still meeting the relevant criteria.
